OPENED AUGUST 18, 1883.

This Library was established by the free will offerings of the people, and begins its career with more than Four Hundred Volumes of carefully chosen new and standard books. The amount contributed to its Treasury to date of opening slightly exceeds Six Hundred Dollars.

TERMS.

A person may become a Subscriber by the payment of One Dollar, and be entitled to draw books from the Library for One Year from date of such payment. Any person who is not a Subscriber will be charged Ten Cents per week for the use of each book, and required to leave a deposit equal to the value of the same.

The above rights are issued subject to the Rules of the Association.

BENEFIT.

The benefit thus offered appears from the fact that any person now paying One Dollar may have the use of over Four Hundred Volumes of books to which additions will steadily be made as the increase of funds allows.

SPIRIT.

The Spirit of the Patchogue Library is unpartisan, popular, and progressive, as may be seen by the distribution of its offices, the members who have contributed to it, and the titles of books in its First Catalogue.
