Any person who is not a Subscriber will be charged Ten Cents per week for the use of each book, and required to leave a deposit equal to the value of the same.

The above rights are issued subject to the Rules of the Association.

The benefit thus offered appears from the fact that any person now paying One Dollar may have the use of over Four Hundred Volumes of books to which additions will steadily be made as the increase of funds allows.
