been guaranteed for maintenance of the Library, Mr. Carnegie
has instructed his cashier to send you the additional Five
Thousand Dollars to cover the additional cost of the Building.

will reimburse Mr. VanPelt for the proportion of the building
he has paid out of his own pocket so far, and that the propor-
tion paid by the community out of its revenues will also be
reimbursed.
